The chart below reflects how the numbers have changed since Friday, September 3. See the daily breakdown below this summary chart for each day's figures.

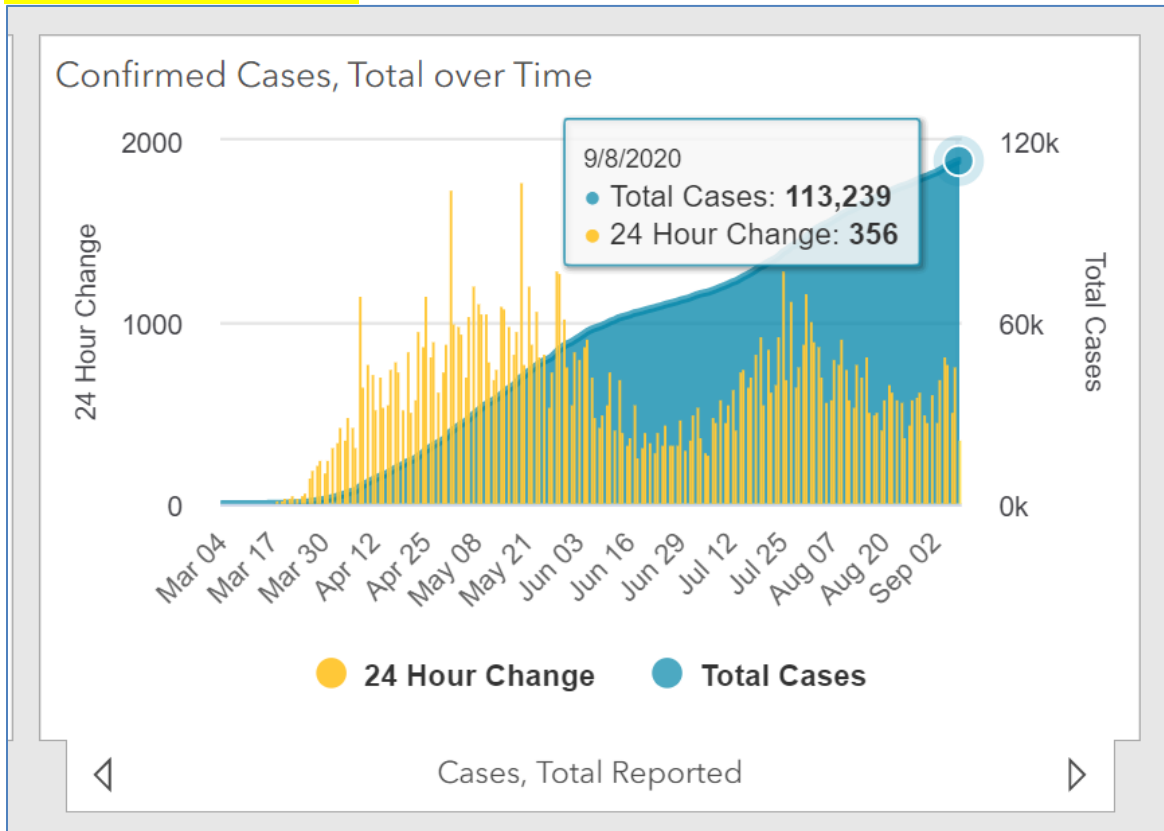

County Executive Alsobrooks Issues New Executive Order

Due to current health metrics, Prince George's County, Montgomery County, Anne Arundel County and Baltimore City chose not to move to Stage Three of Reopening with the rest of the state's counties on Friday, September 4.

To reiterate what is permitted and what is not permitted at present in our county, Prince George's County Executive Alsobrooks issued a new executive order outlining the current operating status. This new order is in effect until September 18.

COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

Prince George's County Child Care Provider Recovery Program



The Child Care Provider Recovery Program provides grants to child care centers that have had to close their doors due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Child care providers may receive a grant up to \$20,000 for licensed child care centers and up to \$3,000 for registered family child care homes to support reopening costs, including personal protective equipment (PPE), payroll, supplies, rent, fixed debt payments and other operating costs.

Application Period:
September 9, 2020 – October 2, 2020

Eligibility:



- Licensed child care center or registered family child care or large family child care home located in the County
- Center is currently closed or recently reopened after July 30, 2020
- Must be in "good standing" with the State of Maryland
- Provide child care to children from birth to the age of five
- Incurred financial losses caused directly or indirectly by the COVID-19 public health emergency
- Not in bankruptcy or litigation
- Have not received funds/support from other County COVID-19 recovery or business relief programs
