Status Report

1. Bowie Companies on Inc. 5000 List

Two Bowie companies are listed on the latest Inc. Magazine list of the 5000 fastest -growing companies:

Advanced Government Solutions has annual revenue of \$6.8 million and 65 employees; *Plan B Technologies* has annual revenue of \$28.2 million and 47 employees.

Both companies are located at Melford.

2. Bowie Dog Park

The Dog Park was recently closed for renovations. Those repairs and improvements will be completed this week. This week, new bumper blocks were installed, the gates repaired, parking lot striping completed and some minor painting and landscape work accomplished. The facility will reopen to the public this Saturday morning.

3. Superintendent Search Community Forum

The Prince George's School System held a Community Forum at Bowie High School on Tuesday, August 21. With the exception of one member, the entire School Board was present as well as Dr. Alvin Crawley, who was just named Interim Superintendent for the PGCPSS system. Tuesday's forum was Dr. Crawley's first formal meeting with the community. His official start date is September 4.

Dr. Crawley spoke briefly outlining his top three priorities for the year. The three include, (1) continued progress for student achievement; (2) efficiently utilizing resources while recognizing funding restraints; (3) engaging the community with the schools, not just families of students, but the entire community.

Approximately 80 people were in attendance. After a brief overview from Ms. Jacobs, community members asked questions ranging from issues with bus routes, how Dr. Crawley was chosen as Interim Superintendent, resources at the secondary school level for young people with disabilities, teacher salaries, and questions on how the School Board represents various districts in the county. The School Board plans to hold more community forums such as this through September and October of this school year.
