COVID Brief

The statewide positivity rate is now 1.44%. For the first time since March 2020, Maryland is reporting under 100 new confirmed cases of COVID-19. Additionally, this week Maryland became the 11th state in the nation to reach the goal of 70% of its adults receiving at least one vaccine dose.

As you make plans this summer, the CDC [recommends](#) getting back into the habit of regular health care, routine screenings, and vaccinations – including one of the COVID-19 vaccines – to help prevent serious health problems, save money, and lead to better health. If you remain concerned about the safety of visiting a health care facility, ask your doctor or healthcare provider about their safety protocols or whether they offer telehealth services. If you've delayed medical care during the pandemic, now is the best time to see your doctor or healthcare provider.

Vaccination Resources

- **State of Maryland** - To get vaccinated—and be eligible for the state’s [\\$2 million Vax Cash Promotion](#)—visit covidvax.maryland.gov, or call 1-855-MD-GOVAX (1-855-634-6829). The call center is available seven days a week, from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. A limited number of drive-thru, no-appointment vaccinations are available at the state-run Six Flags mass vaccination site, Monday to Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Prince George’s County** - Appointments are no longer necessary at all COVID-19 vaccine clinics operated by the County Health Department. Individuals who live or work in the County can walk up to County Health Department vaccination clinics with no appointment needed or book an appointment in advance online at mypgc.us/COVIDVaccine. You can also use the County’s [County Vaccine Locator](#) to find additional vaccination sites operated by pharmacies, hospitals and other healthcare partners.
- **City of Bowie** – Appointments are available at the Bowie Senior Center Vaccination Clinic, which operates on Sundays and Wednesdays. Sign up at www.cityofbowie.org or call City Hall at 301-262-6200 for assistance.
