SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT

On November 23, 2012 at approximately 1232hrs, Bowie Police Officers responded to the 2700 block of Lyn Place for a report of a theft. Upon arrival, Officers were advised by an elderly Victim that his grandson entered the Victim's home without permission, stealing and later cashing bank checks belonging to the Victim. The Victim further advised that his grandson also attempted to gain forced entry to his residence on a later date but was unsuccessful. After the initial report, Bowie Police Officers responded to the Prince George's County Court Commissioner's Office and obtained an arrest warrant against the Victim's grandson for Theft and Burglary charges. The suspect was located, arrested and transported Prince George's County Department of Corrections where he was processed and detained.
