Daily COVID-19 Update for Monday, August 16, 2021

Over 90% of all US counties are reporting substantial or high levels of community transmission, per the CDC. In Maryland, more than half of counties now have high levels of transmission.

Positive Cases Among the Young

According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, between July 29 and August 12, there was a 5% increase the number of COVID-19 cases among children and teens. For the week ending August 12, children made up 18.0% of reported weekly COVID-19 cases in the US.

Maryland seems to be following the national trend. Today the state is reporting 766 new cases and 188 (24.5%) of them are in children and teens under age 20.
