## Daily COVID-19 Update for Friday, August 20, 2021

Beginning today, the County Health Department will administer third doses of Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines at the Sports & Learning Complex to immunocompromised residents (those with weakened immune systems). Residents should check with their healthcare provider to see if they qualify for the booster at this time. Eligible immunocompromised residents seeking a third dose do not need to receive it through the County Health Department. To date, the CDC and FDA have not authorized additional Pfizer or Moderna doses for the general population, but they are expected to do so in September.

Johnson and Johnson have announced that they are engaging with the FDA, CDC, and other health authorities and will be sharing data about the need for a Johnson and Johnson booster shot soon.
