### Remnants of Hurricane Ida To Arrive in our Region

Bowie is expected to feel the effects of the remnants of Hurricane Ida beginning this evening and possibly continuing through to Thursday morning. The National Weather Service is predicting the biggest threats will be heavy rainfall over a sustained period, flash flooding, and an enhanced risk of tornadoes between 2 and 10 p.m. on Wednesday. Winds will begin to increase around noon; because of the gusty winds and saturated ground, downed trees and power outages are possible.

Take steps now to prepare for the storm:


- Secure items that might go airborne in high winds.
- Clear storm drains near your home to prevent flooding.
- Fully charge medical equipment and electronic devices before the storm arrives.
- Make certain you have a working flashlight and spare batteries.

Also, make a plan for where you will shelter in your home or workplace in the event a Tornado Warning is issued.
