Threat of Severe Weather Remains

Tropical Depression Ida has spawned tornados as it moves north, including one that appears to have touched down in Annapolis earlier this afternoon. The threat of severe weather will continue for the next several hours.

Usually the warnings are issued for the projected path a storm is expected to take. They are often quite specific, mentioning cities and neighborhoods. Please remain vigilant. If a warning specifically mentions Bowie, take shelter immediately in an interior space away from windows and doors.

Vaccination Opportunities This Weekend

The Maryland Department of Health GoVAX Summer Tour continues through the Labor Day holiday, providing free mobile vaccine clinics and vaccine outreach at these events/destinations:

- **Sandy Point State Park:** Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Vaccinations are free of charge; however, all visitors must pay the park entry fee.
- **The Maryland State Fair (2200 York Road):** located in the Exhibition Hall. Weekdays from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m.; Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

- **Maryland Renaissance Festival (1821 Crownsville Road):** located outside the main gate. Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
