Vaccine Milestone: 80% of Marylanders Ages 12+ Vaccinated Against COVID-19

Governor Larry Hogan today announced the State of Maryland has officially surpassed the major milestone of vaccinating 80% of all eligible Marylanders 12 and older.

- 80.0% of Marylanders 12 and older received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine
- 81.2% of Marylanders 18 and older received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine
- 94.8% of Marylanders 65 and older received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine

Vaccination Opportunities This Weekend

The Maryland Department of Health GoVAX Summer Tour continues through the Labor Day holiday, providing free mobile vaccine clinics and vaccine outreach at these events/destinations:

- **Sandy Point State Park:** Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Vaccinations are free of charge; however, all visitors must pay the park entry fee.

- **The Maryland State Fair (2200 York Road):** located in the Exhibition Hall. Weekdays from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m.; Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- **Maryland Renaissance Festival (1821 Crownsville Road):** located outside the main gate. Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
