### Hogan Announces Reassessment of Air Filtration in State Schools

Governor Larry Hogan has [directed](#) state agencies to conduct an immediate assessment of ventilation and air filtration in Maryland public school buildings. This decision was made following the early dismissal of 31 schools in Baltimore City due to a lack of proper air conditioning on August 31. Governor Hogan iterated that public health experts have repeatedly stressed that proper ventilation is a critical tool to mitigate the impact of COVID-19.

### Vaccination Opportunities This Weekend

The Maryland Department of Health GoVAX Summer Tour runs through the Labor Day holiday, providing free mobile vaccine clinics and vaccine outreach at these events/destinations:

- **Sandy Point State Park:** Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Vaccinations are free of charge; however, all visitors must pay the park entry fee.
- **The Maryland State Fair (2200 York Road):** located in the Exhibition Hall. Weekdays from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m.; Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- **Maryland Renaissance Festival (1821 Crownsville Road):** located outside the main gate. Saturdays, Sundays, and Labor Day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
