Daily COVID-19 Update for Wednesday, September 8, 2021

While new case numbers in the region appear to be leveling off for now, the number of COVID-related hospitalizations are up. In Maryland today, there are 817 COVID hospitalizations, including 211 patients in the ICU.

Governor Hogan will provide a COVID update to the public this afternoon.
