



**Daily COVID-19 Update for Friday, September 10, 2021**

The Prince George’s County indoor mask mandate remains in place. The mandate was set to expire this week. However, on 9/8, the County Council adopted a resolution which keeps the mandate in place.

On September 9, the president announced the following policy changes to curb the spread of COVID:

- All federal employees and contractors [must be vaccinated against COVID-19.](#)
- The Department of Labor is developing an [emergency rule to require all employers with 100 or more employees](#) to require employees to receive vaccinations or undergo frequent testing.
- TSA will [increase the range of fines](#) that can be imposed on individuals who violate the federal mask mandate on public modes of transportation.
