Anne Arundel Medical Center Limits Some Elective Surgeries for Now

Due to an increase in emergency room visits and COVID admissions, Anne Arundel Medical Center announced on Friday that it is temporarily delaying some elective surgeries. The hospital will evaluate the pause on a weekly basis, but for now, intensive elective surgeries that require patients to recover in the hospital are being postponed. Other healthcare systems in Maryland have said they have sufficient capacity for elective surgeries at this time.
