



COVID-19 NUMBERS

Daily COVID-19 Update for Tuesday, September 21, 2021

On July 1, there were 104 COVID hospitalizations in Maryland. Today's number is 825, which is similar to the figures last seen in early May.

Anne Arundel Medical Center continues to limit non-emergency, non-life threatening surgeries that require overnight hospital stays.
