Pfizer CEO announced on September 27 that the company expects to ask the FDA for authorization of its COVID-19 vaccine for children 5-11 years of age within a “matter of days.”

According to recent data for the region, of those renters who are behind on rent, 24% are waiting to receive pandemic emergency assistance funds, 10% were denied, and the vast majority, more than 60%, did not apply at all.
