

Daily COVID-19 Update for Wednesday, September 29, 2021

According to the Maryland Department of Health, less than 0.59% of fully vaccinated Maryland residents later tested positive for COVID-19. These "break-through" cases represent 11.48% of the COVID cases in Maryland since January.

The American Red Cross is facing an emergency blood and platelet shortage as the nation returns to in-person workplaces and schools amid a surge in COVID-19 cases. Emergency Assistance for Renters

According to recent data for the region, of those renters who are behind on rent, 24% are waiting to receive pandemic emergency assistance funds, 10% were denied, and the vast majority, more than 60%, did not apply at all. If you can't make your rent due to the effects of the pandemic, be sure to explore all your options for assistance.
