Daily COVID-19 Update for Friday, October 8, 2021

Both the state and county positivity rates remain under 4%. Despite this and other encouraging downward data trends, since October 1, 110 Marylanders have lost their lives to COVID.

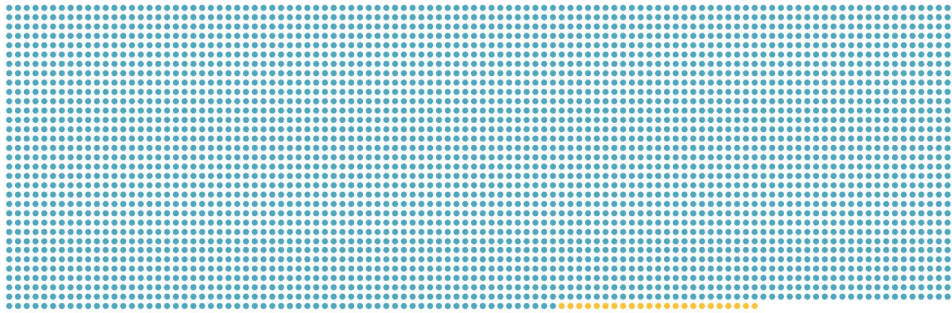
Pfizer has officially submitted a request to the FDA for emergency use authorization for its COVID-19 vaccine in children aged 5 to 12. The FDA's advisory committee will review the request at a meeting on October 26.

Approximately 3.5 million Marylanders are fully vaccinated. Since January, there have been 23,068 breakthrough cases, which represents just 12.2% of all fully vaccinated residents. This information is depicted in graphic below. It is from the covidvax.maryland.gov website.

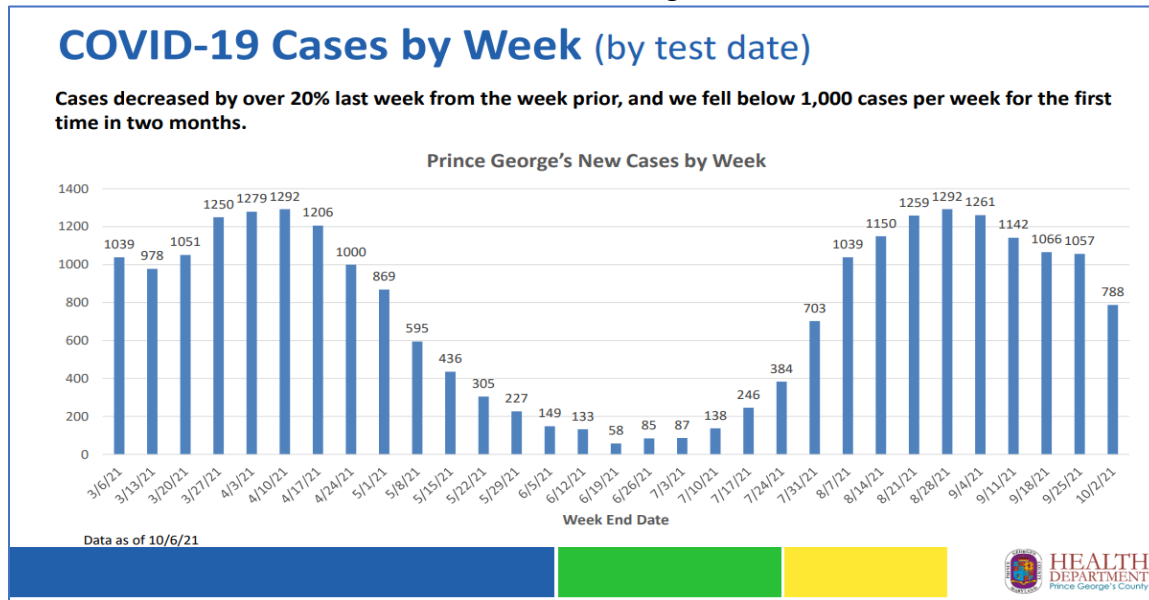
1 Dot = 1,000 fully vaccinated Maryland residents
