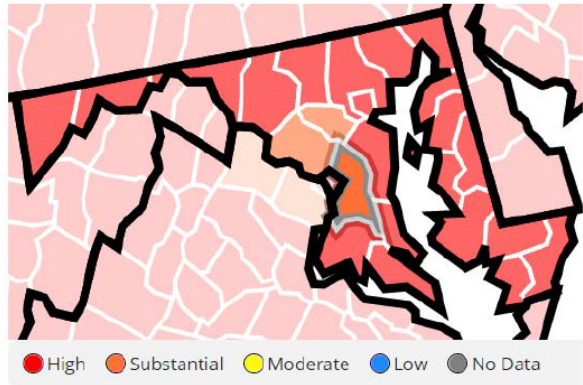
Nursing Home Vaccination Rates

Since September 1, 2021, the Maryland Department of Health has required workers at skilled nursing facilities to have at least their first COVID dose. Most facilities have made excellent progress in complying with this requirement. COVID Transmission Rates

The CDC has lowered Prince George's County's transmission rate to the "substantial" category for the first time in several weeks. It is one of only three counties in Maryland to be at the "substantial" level for the week ending October 4.
