



Daily COVID-19 Update for Tuesday, October 12, 2021

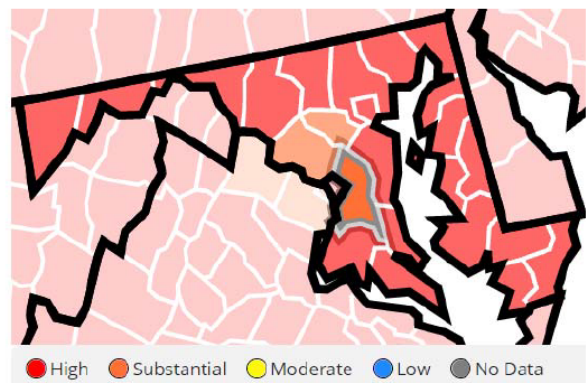
There were only 411 new COVID cases reported in Maryland today. The last time new cases were in this range was late July 2021 before the Delta variant became dominant.

COVID Transmission Rates

The CDC has lowered Prince George's County's transmission rate to the "substantial" category for the first time in several weeks. It is one of only three counties in Maryland to be at the "substantial" level for the week ending October 4.
