Daily COVID-19 Update for Tuesday, October 19, 2021

The CDC has released new guidance for celebrating the winter holidays. The agency says the best way to safely celebrate the holiday season and protect young children who can't yet get a vaccination, is to be fully vaccinated against the coronavirus, if you are eligible. The [guidance](#) also includes tips for indoor travel and protecting yourself and others in certain indoor settings.

Prince George's County's positivity rate averaged 3% last week and today is at 2.98%. This rate keeps the County in the SUBSTANTIAL range. Only 15% of all US counties are below the HIGH transmission rate, meaning they have transmission rates that are LOW, MODERATE or SUBSTANTIAL.
