



Daily COVID-19 Update for Tuesday, November 2, 2021

Today, Maryland is reporting that more than 400,000 booster shots have already been administered and that the state positivity rate has dropped below 3% for the first time since July 30.

State health officials continue to strongly recommend that Marylanders eligible for a booster shot get one as soon as possible—particularly those with underlying health conditions and comorbidities. To find a vaccine provider, visit covidvax.maryland.gov or call 1-855-MD-GOVAX.
