



Daily COVID-19 Update for Thursday, November 18, 2021

The CDC and FDA are expected to decide soon about expanding booster eligibility to all adults.

The number of new cases in the county declined throughout most of October but has leveled off to about 500 a week for the last four weeks.

If you do not have computer access, the public access computers in the Senior Center lobby can be used to book an appointment. Walk-ins will also be accepted as supplies allow.
