SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On January 8, 2013 at approximately 1504 hours, PFC Saunders 0071, received a call for service at 3750 Elder Oaks Blvd in Bowie for a report of a strong arm robbery. Upon arriving on scene, he made contact with Victim 1 and Victim 2. Both victims advised that after they got off the school bus, two black males wearing ski masks approached them and demanded their tennis shoes. When the victims denied their request, the suspects began punching both of them in the facial area with a closed fist. The victims stated that after being punched and falling to the ground, the suspects took the shoes off of the victim's feet by force and fled the scene. The victims advised that the two suspects were possibly fellow students. During the interview with the victims, additional officers arrived on scene and began to set up a perimeter to canvass the immediate area. (Negative results) City of Bowie Police CID Det. Wuthrich and Sgt Polk arrived on scene, the victims were then transported to Bowie Police Station to be further interviewed.
