Old Bowie Celebrates! Festival

Mark your calendar for a day of family-friendly fun at the Old Bowie Celebrates! Festival on Saturday, **October 1**, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. The second annual festival is co-sponsored by Old Bowie Arts & Heritage Committee and the City of Bowie.

The festival features live music and dance, arts and craft vendors, street entertainers, children’s activities, a juried art show, and more. Enjoy a variety of music, from rock to a bagpiper, on several stages. This year, there will be a stage devoted solely to international dancers and music and will feature performers that have previously been seen at the Bowie International Festival. You can also savor local and ethnic foods; and shop artisans and crafters.

Children will find plenty to do. They can explore a special children’s area, which includes games and more hands-on activities. As they move through the festival, they can earn stamps on a festival “passport” and earn a prize. Children and the young at heart can marvel at the Unicycle Lady, a balloon comedian, magicians, and ride the mini train along Heritage Trail.

The festival spans from 12th Street and Chestnut Avenue to Maple Avenue on 9th Street in Old Bowie.

Festival-goers can park at Rockledge Elementary School (on MD 197), American Legion Post (on Old Laurel Bowie Road), or at Huntington South Park (11th St) and ride a free shuttle to and from the festival. Limited parking is also available on the streets of Old Town Bowie.

Bowie Marketplace Consolidated Storage Proposal

Berman Enterprises is submitting an application for Detailed Site Plan approval of a multi-story consolidated storage use and car wash proposal that is intended to replace the approved 225-unit multi-family apartment building on the vacant five acres behind the retail shopping center. A 275,100 square foot consolidated storage building complex consisting of a 132,300 square foot, three-story building (Phase 1) and a 142,800 square foot, four-story building (Phase 2). In addition, a 4,575 square foot car wash building is proposed along Superior Lane.

Per the City Council’s Development Review Guidelines, a City Stakeholders Meeting shall be scheduled as soon as possible, even before an application is officially filed. A virtual Stakeholder’s Meeting and two City public hearings will be held to review the proposal, according to the following schedule:

City Council	Tuesday, January 3 , 2023 at 8:00 p.m.

To attend the virtual meeting, you must register at bowie.fyi/stakeholders10-12. You will receive a confirmation email with the Zoom link for the meeting. During the meeting, participation will be in Listen Only mode, and questions may be sent via the Q&A function. Both public hearings will be held at Bowie City Hall (15901 Fred Robinson Way). No-Cost Flu Shot Clinics at Bowie Senior Center

The Senior Center (14900 Health Center Dr.) will host two flu shot clinics for residents. The first is a high-dose, walk-up clinic for seniors ages 65+ held on Thursday, **September 29** from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. Please bring a Medicare or insurance card. This clinic is conducted in partnership with Safeway.

The second is a drive-up clinic for members of the general public held on Saturday, **October 1** from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. This clinic will only offer regular dose shots, recommended for ages 3 – 65 years old. Minors under the age of 18 will need a parent or guardian signature of consent. Masks are required. This is a drive-up clinic only; no walk ups. This clinic is conducted in partnership with University of Maryland Capital Region Health.

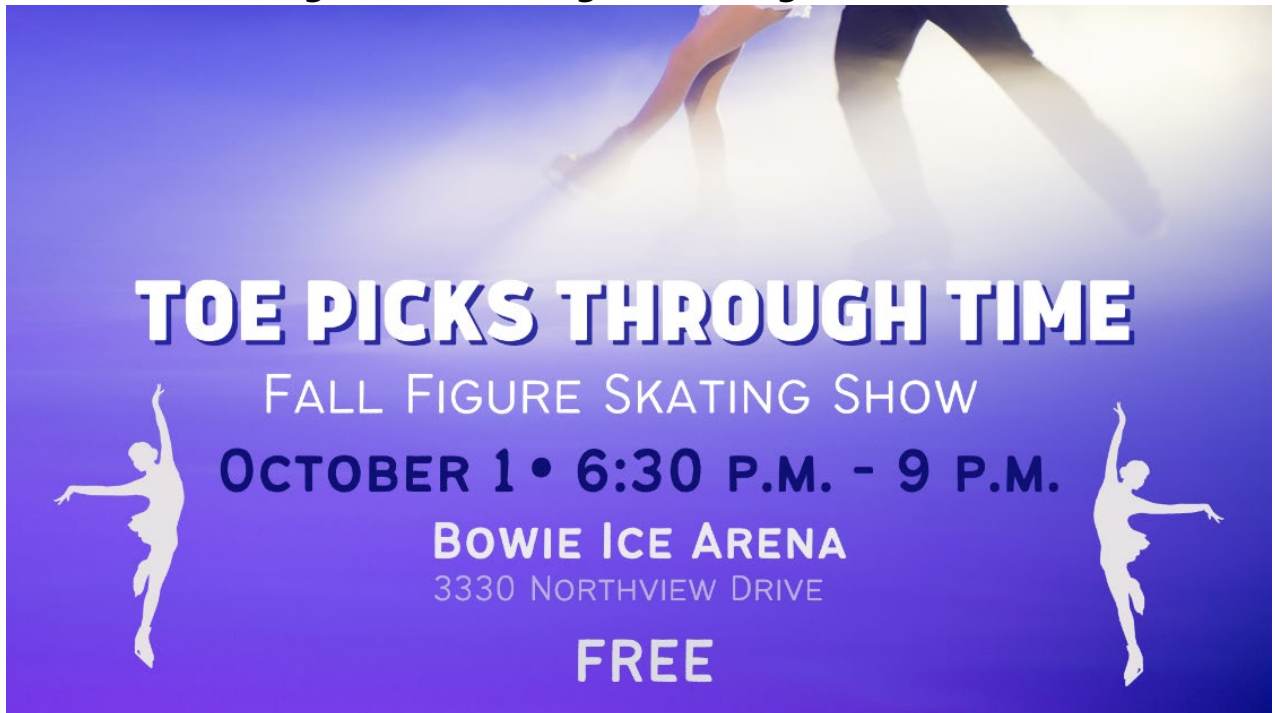
