SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On May 20th, 2013 at approximately 12:30 hours, Bowie Police responded to Dalebrooke Drive for a possible breaking and entering in progress. While Officers were responding to the scene, the dispatcher was advising that the victim could hear the defendants in her home talking to each other and she proceeded to lock herself in her bedroom. As the defendants were attempting to enter her bedroom, Officers arrived on scene. As Officers were doing a perimeter check around her home, they observed an open window to the rear of the home. Subsequently, one Officer observed a hand come out the window and throw some shoes out. The officer proceeded to give the defendant orders to get down and the defendant proceeded to take off on foot. The Officer proceeded to pursue the defendant on foot for approximately ten minutes. The Officer was able to make apprehension in a nearby park. The second suspect was located a short time later by a K9 unit in the adjacent community hiding under a deck. Both individuals were placed under arrest and transported to Bowie Police Station for further questioning.
