



INCIDENT: D.U.I. Arrest

LOCATION: Mt. Oak Road / Nottingham Drive

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: August 31st, 2013 @ 2139 hours.

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On August 31st, 2013 at approximately 2139 hours, Bowie Police Officers were dispatched to a report of an overturned vehicle in the woods off of Mt. Oak Road, east of Nottingham Drive. Upon arrival, Officers observed the driver of the single vehicle accident standing in the middle of the roadway. While gathering information about the accident, Officers smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on the breath of driver. Officer Warrington directed the driver to perform a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests. The driver failed and was taken into custody for suspicion of driving a vehicle under the influence of alcohol. The driver was then transported to the Maryland State Police Barracks in College Park where the driver elected to take part in a breath test. As a result of the breathalyzer test, the driver was found to have a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) of .21; the legal limit is .08 BAC.

No injuries as a result of the accident. The driver was charged accordingly.
