**SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:**

Once Bowie units arrived on scene, they spoke to the victim who reported that while he was in his garage, two unknown suspects dressed in FedEx Uniform Shirts approached him. It was at this time one of the unknown suspects brandished a weapon and attempted to close the garage door. The victim was able to get the handgun away from the suspect. At this time the suspects fled in a dark color Honda in an unknown direction.

An area canvass was conducted with negative results.

There were no injuries reported.
