



INCIDENT: Citizen Robbery (Unarmed)

LOCATION: 16000 Block Excalibur Road- Bowie, MD LOCATION TYPE: Street

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: February 19, 2014 @ 1545 hours

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On February 19, 2014 at approximately 1700 hours, Bowie Police units responded to the Bowie Police Station (15901 Excalibur Road) for a report of a citizen robbery. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with the juvenile victim and his mother who stated that two unknown males approached him in the 16000 block of Excalibur Road on his way home from school. The two unknown males asked the victim if “he had anything on him” to which he replied “no”. At this time, suspect #1 punched the victim in the chest, then suspect #2 pushed the victim to the ground. After doing so, suspect #2 began to go through the victim’s pockets and removed his I-phone. Both suspects then fled on foot towards Bowie Town Center. A track of the victim’s I-Phone directed officers to the 3500 Block of Crain Highway where Officers canvassed with negative results. Bowie Police CID was notified and will be investigating.
