



INCIDENT: Commercial Burglary

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: March 8, 2014 @ 0932hrs

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On March 8, 2014 at 0932 hours, Bowie Officers were dispatched to the National Capital Radio & Television Museum (2608 Mitchellville Road) for a commercial alarm. Upon arrival, Officers discovered that the front door had signs of forced entry. An interior check of the building for suspect(s) revealed negative results. While on-scene, Officers notified a representative of the Museum who immediately responded. The representative advised that no items appeared to be missing at this time. While canvassing the area, Bowie Officers stopped two individuals at Allen Pond Park. Upon further investigation, Officers discovered that the shoe prints found on-scene in the dirt and snow were the same prints on the shoes of both individuals. Both subjects were transported to Bowie Police Station and interviewed by detective(s). One juvenile male subject was subsequently arrested and charged accordingly prior to being released to his parent.
