



INCIDENT: Attempt Commercial Robbery

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On March 9, 2014 at approximately 2034 hours, Bowie Units responded to the Safeway Supermarket located at the 4100 block of Northview Drive for the report of an attempted robbery. Once Bowie Units arrived at that location, they spoke to the cashier who stated an unknown black male was in his check out line and suggested he had a weapon while he demanded the cashier to give him money from the cash register. The cashier refused and the unknown suspect fled that location in a dark colored SUV style vehicle.

An area canvass was conducted with negative results.

There were no injuries and no money was taken. A weapon was implied but not seen.

Prince George's County Robbery Detective Sanders responded and will assume the investigation.
