SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On 9/14/14 at approximately 1530 hours, Patrol units were dispatched to the foot bridge that goes over Rt. 50 between Major Lansdale Blvd. and Kenhill Drive for a report of a juvenile spray painting the bridge. Upon arrival, units observed a juvenile male matching the description for spray painting. Further investigation found that he was just filming a music video, and had a camera, not a paint can. There was no sign of “wet paint” on the bridge.

While PFC Warrington was on foot canvassing for the suspected painter, he observed two males walking out of the woods. He told the males to stop and Mr. Judy stated “we were just smoking weed”. Further investigation found that the males had 33.2 grams of a green leafy substance suspected marijuana, that field tested positive for THC, in their possession. Both males were placed into custody and transported to the Bowie Police Station. After processing, the juvenile, he was released to his father. Mr. Judy was taken to Upper Marlboro Department of Corrections for processing.
