


Background	This Project is part of the City of Bowie's trail maintenance program to enhance the usability, safety and appeal of the Hiker Biker Trail System along Northview Drive.
Proposed Scope	To improve pedestrian and traffic safety, the proposed scope includes modifying Northview Drive to reduce from four-lane to 2-lanes road in the area near Easton and Everette Drives, relocating mid-block pedestrian crosswalk to align with the trail, and lighting improvement at the pedestrian crossing.
