


Underground storage tank (UST) Replacement

Background	The City of Bowie owns and operates two underground storage tanks (USTs) at the Public Works Yard for use in fueling operations, including one 8,000-gallon (gal) diesel UST and one 10,000-gal gasohol UST, installed in 1988 and 1996 respectively. As UST's typical service life is 30 years, the City plans to replace both existing USTs at the Public Works Yard.
Project Scope	This project includes removal and replacement of the two USTs and associated appurtenances, including fuel dispensers, connection of the new USTs and dispensers to the existing tank management system and fuel management system, installation and maintenance of temporary fuel system, piping, site restoration, erosion and sediment control measures, and new fencing, <i>etc.</i>
